Orana Wildlife Trust Volunteer

Thank you for your interest in volunteering at Orana Wildlife Park. The following information will assist you in completing the application process.

Position Description

Set in 80 hectares, Orana Wildlife Park is New Zealand's only open range zoo. The Park is home to nearly 400 animals representing over 70 different species. Operating as a charitable trust, Orana fulfils an important role in managed, zoo-based breeding programmes for the species we hold.

Volunteers are a key part of the Park's operation. They primarily assist with visitor services, helping us achieve our conservation advocacy objectives whilst ensuring guests have an enjoyable visit. We also welcome skilled people who wish to volunteer their services to the Park in a wide range of gardening and light maintenance work. Overall, volunteering is a challenging, varied and interesting role.

We currently have two programmes: Senior Volunteers (18 years and over) and Assistant Volunteers (15 to 17 years).

Senior Volunteers (18 years and over)

Senior volunteers carry out a range of duties depending on the skills and interests of the individual.

There are four distinct Senior Volunteer roles:

- **Walkabout Guides** lead visitors on a tour around the zoo from one animal feed to the next. They provide key information to visitors, deliver presentations and assist at public animal feeds, particularly the Farmyard and Giraffe feeds.
- **Shuttle Drivers** conduct tours on our electric shuttle circuit while providing an educational and entertaining commentary.
- **Grounds and Maintenance Volunteers** do gardening and light to heavy maintenance work depending on the abilities and interests of the individual.

Other Senior Volunteer duties include:

- Assisting in 'tailored' visits such as tours with the elderly or disabled, Cruise Ship tours and/or education programmes.
- Face painting.
- 'Housekeeping' and light maintenance duties such as cleaning, sweeping, shredding paper, etc.

Assistant Volunteers (15 – 17 years)

Assistant volunteers primarily help our Animal Keepers in the Farmyard with the cleaning and maintenance of enclosures. They also assist Senior Volunteers at key animal feeds and with a variety of other housekeeping and light maintenance tasks.

The successful applicant must possess the following attributes:

- Be a team player and a reliable person with a 'can do' attitude
- Excellent oral communication skills
- Outstanding customer service and people skills with a positive, polite and friendly personality
- A passion for conservation and the aims of the Trust
- Be safety conscious and able to work with minimal supervision

We ask that Volunteers complete a minimum of two rostered days per month, working approximately 9.30am until 4.30pm each day. Hours outside of this can be arranged with the Visitor Services Co-ordinators. Private transport is essential as there is no public transport to the park.

Application Process

Attached is an Orana Wildlife Park Volunteer application form that you are required to personally complete. Our team review each application and select suitable candidates for interviews.

The position is based at Orana Wildlife Park, McLeans Island Road, Christchurch, New Zealand.

Rewards

Appreciation vouchers are awarded to Volunteers at the completion of every 100 hours of service.

Uniform

A uniform is issued to each volunteer on completion of 100 hours of service. This consists of a branded polo shirt and fleece vest. Prior to completing 100 hours, volunteers may borrow a uniform. It is recommended that all Volunteers wear practical, tidy clothing; preferably dark in colour.

Training

A comprehensive training and evaluation programme is in place to help Volunteers learn about the Park and its animals whilst being able to convey accurate information to visitors.
